Spread The Word!

All of us should be interested in spreading the word of God. Without the preaching or teaching of the word of God there can be no faith, no hearing, no confession, and no salvation (Rom. 10: 9-17).

In Paul's letter to Timothy, he gave us this threefold plan of getting the gospel out to others: *"And the things which thou hast heard from me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also"* (2 Tim 2:2).

First of all we ourselves must hear. Paul writes of *"the things which thou hast heard from me among many witnesses."* We must hear and receive this word *"with all readiness of the mind, examining the Scriptures daily, whether these things"* are so (Acts 17:11). To receive the word we must hear with our ears, perceive with our eyes, understand with our hearts and turn to the Lord that we may be forgiven (Mt. 13:15).

Second, we must commit the message we have heard to faithful men. We should never be guilty of keeping the precious message of the gospel to ourselves. It is not a message to be hoarded but a message to be shared with all. This must be taught in such a way that others with honest and good hearts may receive and obey the word of truth (Luke 8:15).

And third, the process must start all over again. Those who have heard from the faithful men, hopefully, will *"be able to teach others also."*

So what is the process by which the gospel is proclaimed? First, receive it yourself. Next, teach it to others and third teach them in such a way that they in turn can teach. Then, the process starts all over again.
