Can You Write That Down?

Two weeks ago I had, what I thought, was a pretty good idea for a bulletin article. However, I also had another idea that was more appropriate for what was going on at the time and I used that one instead. The key word in paragraph is *had*, because that idea has flown from my mind. The trouble is I didn't write it down and now I am writing an article about something I forgot—ironic isn't it? Are you still with me? Well, maybe this verse will help you see where I'm going.

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates (Deuteronomy 6:4-9).

You may say, "Isn't that overdoing it?" Well, considering the, "Forgotten" I just wrote about I would say not. The command to the Israelites was to not let God become secondary in their lives. Teach it to your children, speak of Jehovah constantly, write down His words, follow His commands, write it on your doors so you remember, Who gave you your home and Who should preside over it.

Writing something down gives it permanence. Practicing it makes it a part of you. So, maybe we need to take this passage to heart and write down some of God's desires for us, set them as reminders on our cell phones, inscribe them on our email, tape them on our dashboards, write them on our soccer balls, let His word become so much a part of us that we take it wherever we go. "Hear, O Christian: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. "

Pictorial Directory Update

1. A **rough copy** of the new pictorial directory has been laid out on the table in the foyer. Check the rough directory to see if you have a page there. If you do, check the information to see if it is current. If you have no picture or would like a new picture, see Stephanie Copas or Gary Glispie right away. They will make the picture before or after any service, it's just a matter of a few seconds.

2. **If you do not have a page in the current directory**, check the typed version of the directory laying on the table for your name.

- **A line beside your name** means we have no information and no picture.
- **"All old"** means that in the rough copy of the new directory we have used your old picture and old information. If it is ok, you don't need to do anymore.
- **"Old Pic"** means we have put your old directory picture in the rough copy (which is fine if you are happy with it, but you may want to update the picture).
- **"Old Info"** means we have a new picture but the information may need to be updated.
- **"No Pic"** means we need a picture.
- **"Need New Pic and Info"** probably means you have gotten married or had a baby or something so we need a new picture and new information.

3. **If new information is needed**, fill out one of the information sheets on the table and when you have completed it, put it on the bottom of the pile of blank sheets.

4. **If a new picture is needed**, get with Gary Glispie or Stephanie Copas before or after services and get your new picture made ASAP.

Gary will be standing close to the table after services to answer any questions you may have about the process.
